Rogue Ospreys Academic Data

The following information is a snapshot of a Rogue student-athlete's academic progress. This information is gathered from the official eligibility forms which are submitted to the NWAC office and the Rogue department of Institutional Research. This includes the number of students who attended in the prior year and who received athletically related aid, categorized by race and gender within each sport. (Basketball, football, baseball, cross-country and track combined, and all other sports combined. At RCC that leaves only two groups: Cross-Country, and "all other" as soccer and volleyball). The AVERAGE completion or graduation rate, and if applicable, transfer-out rate, of the four most recently completing or graduating classes by race and gender. Transfer out rate is based on those who do not attain a certificate or associate's degree but transfer to another two-year or four-year institution. Four-year transfer rate is based on the student-athlete who transfers to a four-year institution and was officially enrolled, regardless of whether they earned a certificate or degree from Rogue or continued to participate in sports at the four-year institution. Completed rate is based on those who either graduated or transferred out to another institution. These numbers are not a perfect reflection, as they do not acknowledge those students who may transfer into a program within the same institution, or another two-year institution, for a program such as Nursing, EMT, Dental Assisting, or other specialty programs. It also doesn't include students who may have completed the necessary coursework but didn't officially apply for the degree evaluation. It also can affect numbers if a student-athlete transferred to our school with only one year of eligibility remaining.
